PINOT GRIGIO

For over a century, our past generations have produced grapes and wines of quality and authenticity from the foothills of the Andes Mountains. Selected from small lots in our high altitude vineyards, the grapes for this wine showcase dense, concentrated black fruit aromas and flavors.

Winemaking

This Pinot Grigio comes from the foothills of the Andes Mountains, in the Uco Valley, Mendoza, at 1,100 meters above sea level. The soil is sandy and rocky. The climate typically presents hot days and cold nights, with a considerable temperature variation. Harvest takes place in two different moments: an early harvest to obtain good acidity and freshness and floral notes. A second harvest is carried out to obtain tropical fruits aromas.

Tasting Notes

The Tolentino Winemaker's Selection Pinot Grigio has a light yellow-green color with intense notes of white flowers, delicate and complex aromas of jasmine, yellow fruits, a natural well-balanced acidity and long elegant finish.
